Guidelines for choosing a class:

Advanced Instrument: Appropriate for advanced and master musicians, and those that feel somewhere between intermediate and advanced, have played over five (5) years in Cape Breton/Irish music and can read music well or can play quickly by ear. Looking for technique, stylizations and direct improvement in problem areas of playing Cape Breton/Irish music and more advanced/complicated tunes.

Advanced Dance: You have been dancing for more than three years and have a good working knowledge of Step Dancing.

Intermediate Instrument: Appropriate for intermediate musicians and those that feel they are well versed in other types of music but have played Cape Breton/Irish music for less than five (5) years; or have been playing Cape Breton/Irish music for more than five years but need more instruction/support in critical areas. Can read music or learn by ear fairly quickly.

Intermediate: Dance: You have been dancing for one to three years and have some experience with Step Dancing

Basic Instrument: Appropriate for those musicians who have been playing their instrument for at least one year, know simple tunes and can play by written music or by ear at a slower level.

Basic Dance: You have been dancing for less than a year and have little or no experience with Step Dancing

Beginner Instrument/Dance: You have very little or no experience with the instrument/dance. Fiddles and Bodhrans only will be provided for the Beginner classes.

PIANO students must provide their own keyboards.

Fiddle Summit: "It all sounds the same!".....How many times have your 'non-musician' friends made this remark when it comes to 'Celtic Music?' There ARE a lot of similarities in the reels, and jigs played in Irish music and Cape Breton music. But there are also a lot of differences. In this workshop you will have the opportunity to see and hear some of the best musicians in their particular tradition compare and contrast the Gaelic inspired music from each country and the regional differentiations that bring that particular 'flavor' to each musicians style.

The Fiddle Summit, hosted by Janine Randall, founder of the Ceilidh Trail School of Music in Cape Breton Island, will lead the entire fiddle faculty, accompanied by Dennis Cahill and Pat Gillis in a discussion and demonstration of tunes that are common to both the Irish and Cape Breton repertoire. Each instructor will be asked to play through a tune and talk about how they approach the music and what they do to make it artistically their own. In the second 45 minutes the students in the audience will be invited to take out their instruments and join the masters for a traditional session pulling tunes from both the Irish and the Cape Breton tradition. All instruments are welcome. The charge for this discussion/session will be \$30.00.
